Prize Fund and Entry Fees

- First Place: \$3,000
- Entry Fee: \$160 Payment Options: Cash, Check (made out to "Championship Bowling"), or Venmo (@chayton-petersen)
- Reentry Fee: \$100

Divisions and Format

- **Divisions**: Open and Under (Under division is for bowlers with an average of 205 and below or CB TOUR average of 188 or under)
- Format:
 - 1 in 6 bowlers from each division will advance to the Cashers Round.
 - Sunday Cashers Round: 4 games
 - Cut to top 16 for the bracket finals:
 - Top 4 bowlers: 2-round bye (if 23 or fewer cashers)
 - Bowlers seeded 5-8: 1-round bye (if 23 or fewer cashers)
 - If 24 or more cashers: cut to top 24, seeds 1-8 get a 1-round bye.

Qualifying Rounds

- **5 games** across 5 pairs of lanes per squad.
- Bowlers can reenter, and their highest qualifying score will carry over to the Cashers Round.
- 1 in 6 bowlers from both divisions move to the Cashers Round.
- Bowlers will use their CB TOUR average to determine eligibility for the Under Division, if there is no CB TORU average of at least 15 games for a bowler, their highest USBC composite average from '23-'24 will be used.

Cashers Round Rules

- The highest qualifying score will carry over to the Cashers Round.
- The top 16 or top 24 bowlers (depending on cashers count) will be seeded into the bracket.
 - Tiebreakers:

For ties on the cut line or seeding, a 1-game roll-off will be used, followed by sudden-death roll-offs if necessary. The bowler with the highest single game in the Cashers Round will have lane choice and decide who finishes first.

Bracket Finals

- Top 16 or 24 bowlers will compete in a best-of-two-games format.
- High seed gets lane choice and decides the order of bowling.
- Practice times:
 - 10 minutes before Round 1
 - 4 minutes before Rounds 2 and 3
 - 2 shots per lane in Rounds 4 and 5

Lanes will be reconditioned before the start of the bracket.

CB TOUR Doubles Format Overview

1. Crossover Doubles

- Pick as many partners as you want!
- Your partner must bowl the same squad as you.
- Entry Fee: \$10 per bowler, which must be paid in full before the first bowler in your team bowls.

2. CB Doubles Shootout

- Partner with one other bowler and use your qualifying scores for the shootout event.
- **Cut**: Top 4 teams advance to a Baker-style bracket immediately following the final qualifying squad.
- Entry Fee: \$50 per bowler, which must be paid in full before the first bowler bowls. Important Notes for the Shootout:
 - You may only bowl with one partner if your team is inside the cut.
 - If your team is outside the cut, you may bowl again with either the same partner or a different one.
 - You can continue to bowl with your original partner to improve your score while inside the cut.
 - You are not allowed to bowl with a different partner while still inside the cut with your original team.

3. Qualifying Scores

- Both events (Crossover Doubles and CB Doubles Shootout) will use your **main event qualifying scores**.
- **CB Experience Division**: If you would like to participate in Crossover Doubles, CB Doubles Shootout, High Game Pot, or brackets again without reentering the main event, you can choose to bowl in the **CB Experience Division**. However, your scores will not count toward the cashers' round if you score higher, so bowl at your own risk!

Handicap and Averages

- Handicap: 75% of 220
- Bowlers' Averages:

Bowlers will use their CB TOUR average. If no CB TOUR average is available, the bowler's highest composite USBC average from the most recent season (minimum of 21 games) will be used.

- For bowlers with "Sport" or "Challenge" averages, the USBC's conversion chart will be applied to convert to a standard average.
- This converted average will then be reduced by 18 pins to establish a CB TOUR average.

Tournament Format

- Cashers: 1 in 4 entries will cash.
- **Beat the Board Format**: The highest scores across all qualifying squads will determine winners.
- Qualifying:
 - 5 games bowled across 5 different pairs of lanes per squad.
 - Bowlers may reenter, and their highest score will be used for cashing and awards.

Competition Conditions

- Lane Conditions: Bowlers will bowl on the same lane patterns as the main CB TOUR event.
- **Crossing**: Challenge Series bowlers will cross lanes with main event bowlers, and all CB TOUR playing rules apply.
